Introduction

- 1 The Faculty of Health Dean's Commendation List identifies each semester students who achieve academic excellence. The commendations are restricted to students enrolled in the Faculty's single and double bachelor-level degree programs.

Guidelines

- 2 To be eligible a student must have completed at least 36 credit points in the semester under review with a grade point average (GPA) of 6.1 or above for the units undertaken in the semester. "T" results for units with ongoing assessment are not included in the credit point count.
- 3 The commendation list is formulated twice each year, after results for deferred examinations are finalised. Semester two and summer semester are combined on one list. On finalisation of the list, the Faculty Office will arrange for each eligible student to receive a congratulatory letter from the Dean. A copy of the Commendation List will be placed on each School's noticeboard for public display and on the Faculty website.
