Course overview

How is ethical conduct in organisations and institutions developed? How is it sustained and embedded into a workplace culture? Ethical conduct is a product of the context in which people operate. Leaders need to understand how their behaviour as a leader helps shape this system and how to build a strong culture that minimises the risk of unethical conduct.

Who should participate?

This course is designed for team leaders and program managers who want to take charge of how their behaviour and choices as a leader shape their organisation's ethical conduct and minimise the risk of ethical issues in the workplace.

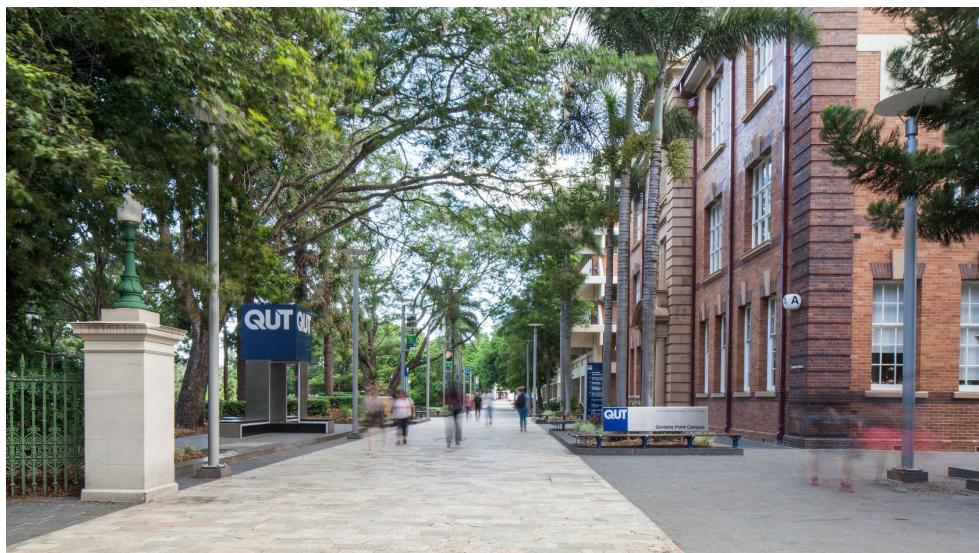
