# Occupational Health and Safety Management

## Develop your understanding of critical Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) management elements.

Learn how you can combine systematic management and systems thinking to improve safety and support resilience in your organisation.

This course provides a comprehensive overview of the different aspects of managing OHS at an enterprise level.

The course focuses on various OHS management approaches, the role and requirements of relevant standards, and major OHS management areas, including risk management, safe design and OHS performance, emergency preparedness, investigations, auditing and culture.

This course offers an optional assessment module, comprised of an essay (critical analysis of a topic relevant to current challenges and debates on one or more areas of OHS Management) and end of semester examination.

On successful completion of the assessment module, participants will be eligible to apply for advanced standing for the corresponding unit in related Health, Safety and Environment award courses at QUT or other educational institutions subject to their policies.

Occupational Health and Safety staff and any professional with a human-centred mindset from any industry sector (e.g., construction, energy, healthcare, and transport) will benefit from the knowledge shared in this course which is delivered in a highly interactive learning environment and offers continuous support with access to additional material.

## Core concepts

On completion, participants will be able to:

- Critically analyse the systems approach to OHS management.
- Interpret standards and best practices relevant to OHS management systems to support legislative compliance and organisational performance.
- Approach critically and apply theories, concepts, and strategies relevant to workplace OHS management systems.
- Investigate, analyse, evaluate, and improve OHS (management) performance and compliance.
