APPLICATION

Students are required to submit an application providing:

- CV including academic GPA and PEX placement reports
- Personal statement outlining reasons for undertaking a professional experience placement in a regional, rural or remote location and how this will contribute to their course or career objectives.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Recipients must be
 - Enrolled in any of the following courses:
 - > Final year Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood, Primary or Secondary)
 - > Final year Master of Teach (Early Childhood, Primary or Secondary)
 - Enrolling in first attempt at second last PEX placement in Semester 1, 2023
 - Consideration will be given to students out of step in their study program and enrolling in their final PEX placement in Semester 1, 2023
 - Undertaking your PEX placement within 50 kilometres of any of the following regional locations:
 - Bundaberg
 - Gladstone
 - Rockhampton
 - Mackay
 - > Townsville
 - Cairns
 - Minimum GPA 5.0

BURSARY OFFERS AND ACCEPTANCES

- 2. Bursary offers will be made to the four highest ranked applicants.
- 3. An acceptance form will be provided to successful recipients in the offer letter (email).
- 4. Failure to accept a Bursary offer by the due date will result in the Bursary being relinquished back to QUT and re-offered in Semester 2.
- 5. This Bursary cannot be deferred.

RETAINING THE BURSARY

- 6. Recipients are expected to remain enrolled full-time for the duration of the studies to retain this scholarship.
- 7. Recipients wishing to take a break from study must apply for, and be granted, a Leave of Absence. Bursary payments are suspended whist students are on an approved Leave of Absence.
- 8. In the event of special circumstances occurring while in the receipt of this scholarship, students must contact the University Scholarships Coordinator to discuss their situation (scholarships@qut.edu.au). Special circumstances will be taken into consideration to support individual variation to the Bursary retention requirements (supporting documentary evidence may be requested).

BURSARYPAYMENT

9. The Bursary payment will be made upon written confirmation from the Professional Experience Placement Coordinator of your acceptance to the placement within the regional, rural or remote guidelines noted in the eligibility section.

OTHER INFORMATION

10. This Bursary is bound by the Bursary Concurrency Policy that determines whether certain Bursary combinations can be held concurrently by a student. **This is an Industry bursary**. Refer to the table below.

To determine if you can hold more than one scholarship, locate Scholarship Type A on the X axis and Scholarship Type B on the Y axis then slide down and across simultaneously until you reach the concurrency decision for that combination. The type can be confirmed in the respective terms and conditions of the Bursary in question.
