The information below is considered your event briefing – please be at the start line for a race briefing five minutes prior to your race start time.

Kit collection

Gardens Point, Y Block, Level 5 Reception

When to collect your pack

- Thursday 14 May 10am – 6pm
- Friday 15 May 10am – 6pm
- Saturday 16 May 8am – 2pm

Can someone else collect my pack?

Yes. Please have a copy of the confirmation email.

Race bib

Collect your race bib at Race Kit Collection. On race day, pin your bib to the front of your shirt. Your bib contains your race timing chip and your results will be published online. Your bib number links to your race photos, so you can search for photos of yourself after the event. The tear-away tag at the bottom of your bib must be attached to your bag for bag drop. **No bib tag = no bag drop.**

Bag drop

Our event has grown this year and to accommodate for this we have a 10km/1km bag drop and a separate 5km bag drop. Use your bib tear-away tag to check in your items.

Event t-shirt

For those who registered prior to 31 March, your event shirt will be given out at kit collection. We are unable to swap your shirt for a different size at kit collection. If you require a different size visit our stall at the event where we will be selling them on the day.

Late entries

Online registration will close at 11:59pm, Monday 11 May (AEST).

Toilets

Public toilets are available along Gardens Point Road. Please note that toilets at X Block will be closed this year. P Block toilets will be open and accessible to all participants. The Library in V Block will also be open for students and staff with valid card-swipe access.

The venue and parking

The QUT Classic will be located at the Gardens Point campus. Parking is available to staff, students and the general public. All parking on campus on event day will incur a flat fee of \$10. Enter the car park and press the green button to receive your ticket. When you return to the car park, you can pay at any pay station with card payment only.

Food and drink

There will be a range of food and drink options available on event day. Lady Harriets cafe will be open from 6am. QUT student clubs will be running a BBQ and serving pancakes on the east lawn.

Activations

A range of activations will be available on site, offering various products and services such as RHP Physiotherapy and QUT Podiatry, who will be providing complimentary post-race recovery services for participants. The Cube located at P Block will be open for families to engage with the interactive learning screens.

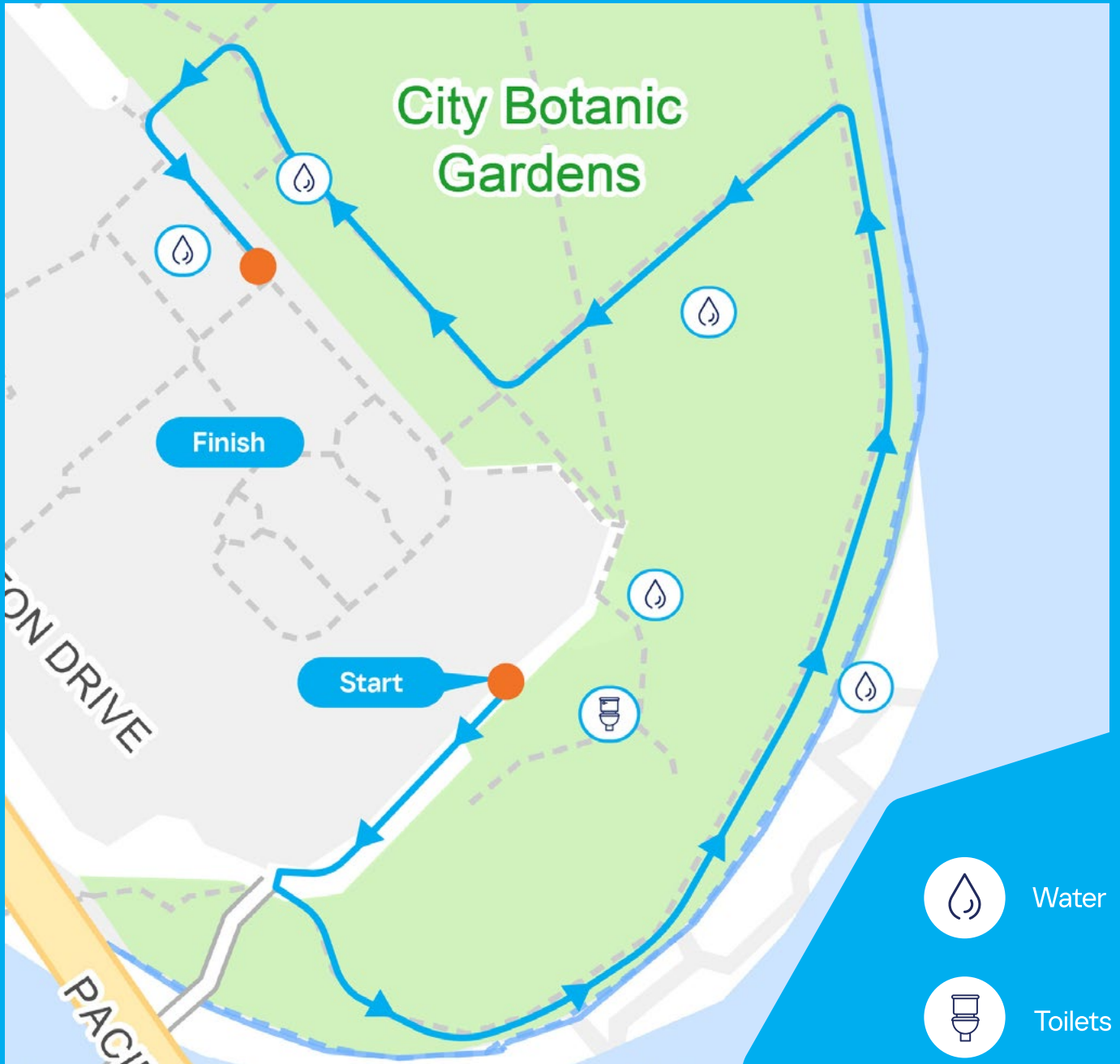
CHOOSE FROM THREE DISTANCES

EVENT DAY MAP

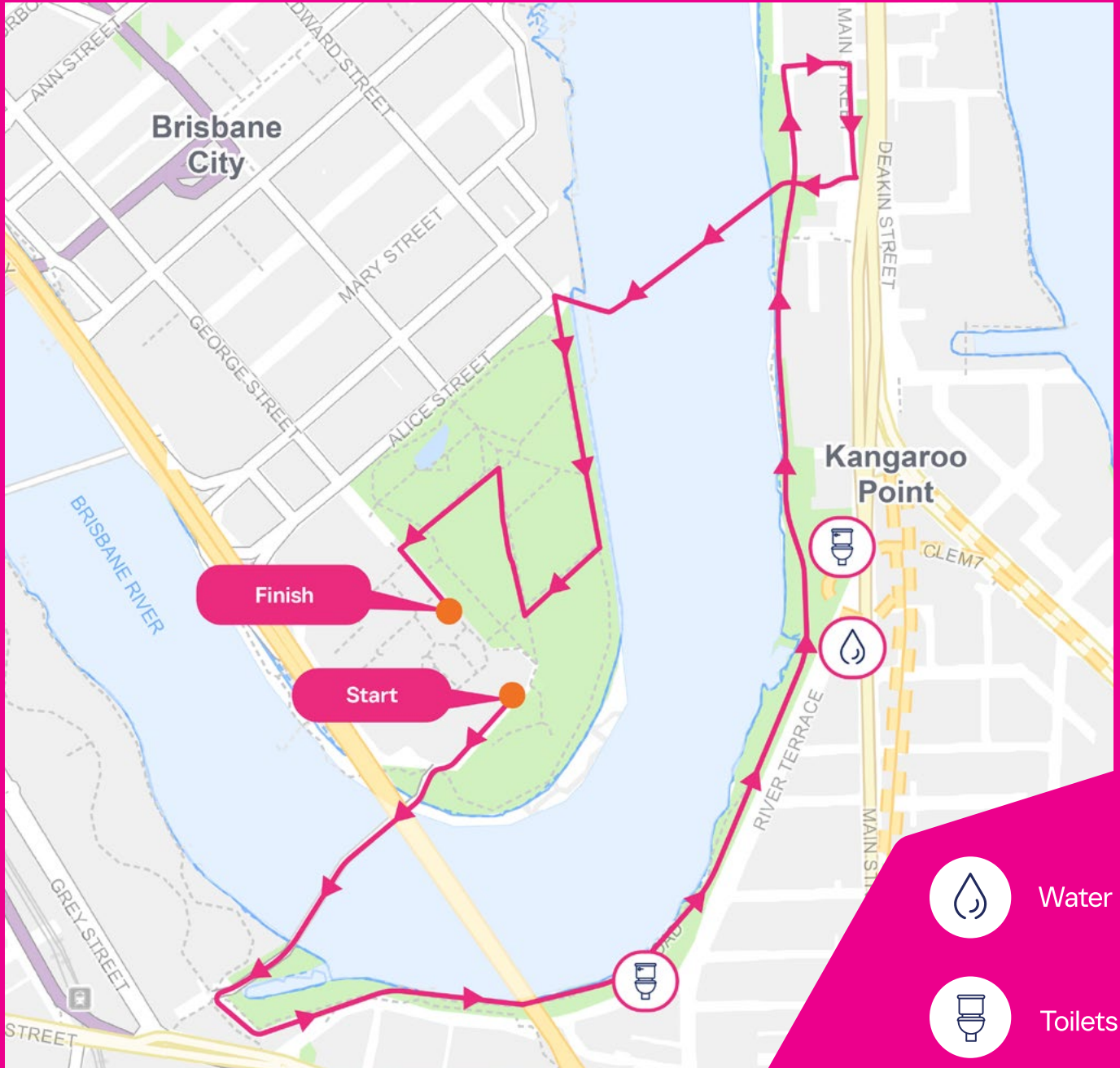


1KM COURSE MAP

ON COURSE INFORMATION

Running with headphones

If you choose to wear headphones, please ensure the volume is at a reasonable level so that you are able to hear instruction from course officials.

Keep left

Please keep to the left when possible to allow for faster runners to pass easily. Some parts of the course are extremely tight and will require single file. Please be aware of runners coming in the opposite direction.

All participants must stick to the footpath and are not to use the adjacent cycle path. Please be aware and mindful of members of the public including cyclists.

Running with a pram

Yes, you may run with a pram. However, we ask if you can please start at the back of the race to ensure safety for your child as well as respect for other competitors.

Running with a child

Running whilst carrying a child of any age whether in a front or back baby carrier/harness is not permitted during the event, as it poses a substantial safety risk. Walking whilst carrying a baby or child is permitted as long as their safety and welfare is not compromised. Children aged 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult or guardian.

Water stations

In addition to public drinking fountains, we will have two water stations on course approximately 2.1km and 5.9km along the course. Our hydration partner Body Armour will be providing recovery drinks and ice blocks at the finish line.

Medical aid

Our event day medical team will be from 1300MEDICS and will be on course and at the finish line to help with any medical assistance you may need. If you are on course and require medical attention, please reach out to one of our volunteers on course to get in contact with the medical team.

Can I bring my pet?

Unfortunately furry friends are not allowed. Registered guide dogs are always welcome.

Extreme weather

QUT Classic will ensure we provide a duty of care to all participants and staff, with the well being of individuals being of highest importance. Extreme weather may be defined as weather that threatens the immediate or long-term safety of individuals.

In the case where we make the decision to cancel the event, notice will be made at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time, and where possible, will be posted to the QUT Sport social media channels. QUT Classic organisers will also email participants.

AFTER THE EVENT

Finish line

Once you have crossed the line, keep moving through the finish chute to the recovery area. You do not need to hand back your race number. Please avoid congregating at the finish line.

Medals

You will receive one of our eco-friendly finisher medals at the completion of your event.

Complimentary food and drink

Fresh fruit and water will be available at our recovery stations. Please dispose of your rubbish using one of our bins provided.

Presentations

All race presentations will commence at 8:35am.

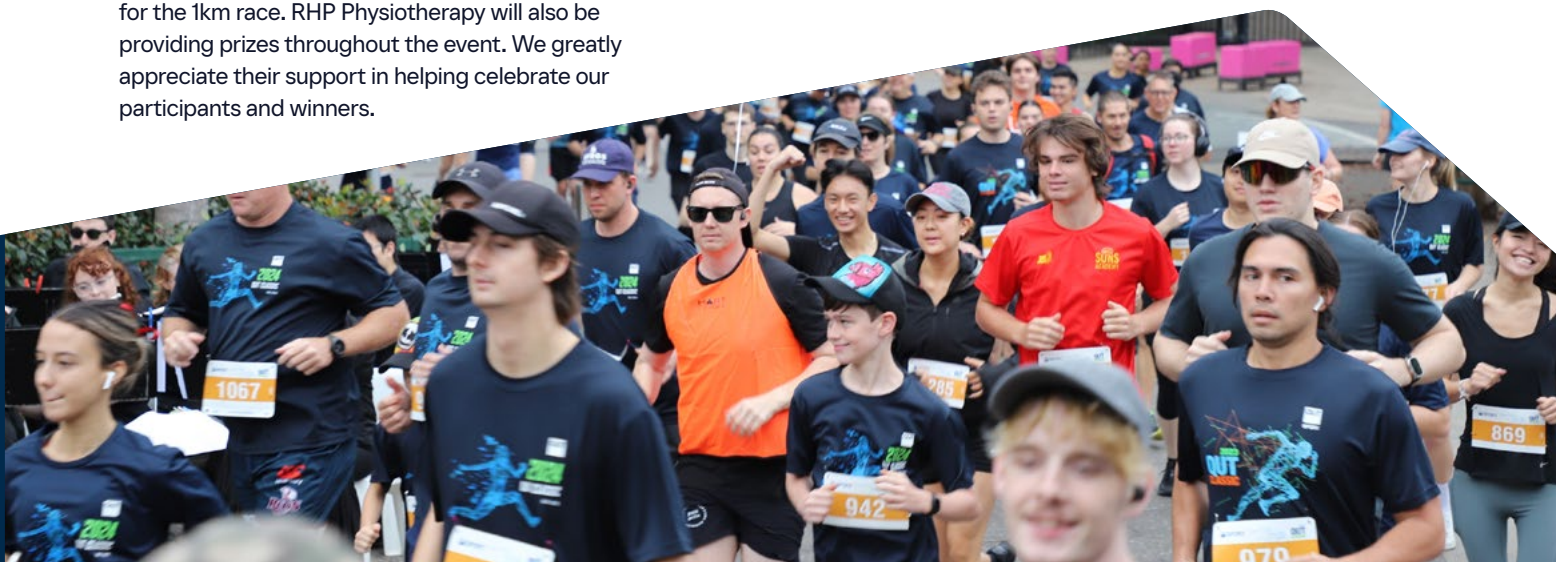

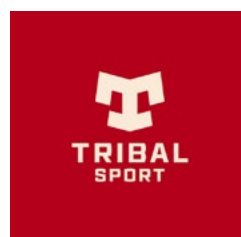
