



The John Stainton International Bursary TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GENERAL

1. Closing date for applications is 11.59pm, Monday 5 April 2021. Late applications will **not** be accepted.
2. To be eligible for the John Stainton International Bursary applicants must meet the following criteria:

A. ENROLMENT

4. Recipients must remain enrolled as a full-time student at QUT for the duration of the studies to retain their scholarship.
5. After first semester, students are able to take approved Leave of Absence for up to 12 months (in accordance with QUT Student Rules) and still retain the scholarship. Scholarship payments will not be made to the scholar while on an approved Leave of Absence.

B. RECIPIENT PERFORMANCE OBLIGATIONS

6. All The John Stainton International Bursary recipients must maintain a course grade point average (GPA) of 5.0 or greater in any given semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period. Failure to maintain this condition may result in the scholarship being terminated.
7. All The John Stainton International Bursary recipients must utilise the bursary towards an international real world learning experience, such as a Global Mobility program, study tour, or work integrated learning experience.

C. SCHOLARSHIP VALUE AND DISBURSEMENT

8. The one semester bursary valued at \$1,500 will be paid as a study stipend of \$1,500 per semester and will be paid after the HECS census dates (normally in March and August each year) once the recipient has completed 144 credit points of creative industries units. The payment will be made upon the recipient confirming the use of the bursary funds as per their application or aligned to the bursary criteria.
9. While every care is taken to ensure direct payments of scholarship funds are correct, scholarships recipients are required to monitor payments and notify QUT if any over or under payments occur. If under payments occur, the balance will be paid to the student immediately. If over payments occur the scholarship recipient is required to advise QUT immediately and repay the overpaid amount.

D. GRIEVANCES

E. CONCURRENCY

12. For all intents and purposes The John Stainton International Bursary is classed as a Bursary scholarship.
13. The John Stainton International Bursary is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy. The QUT Scholarships Concurrency Policy determines whether certain scholarship combinations can be held by a student concurrently. Refer to the concurrency table provided below.

To determine if a combination of scholarships can be held concurrently by a student, determine scholarship type A on the Y axis and Scholarship Type B on the X axis and slide down and across simultaneously until you reach the concurrency decision for that scholarship combination.
