



QUT Snapshot

- The total number of students in 2023 was 52,070 (35,792 full-time equivalent).
- QUT had a total of 9,815 international students from 128 countries in 2023.
- QUT had a total of 12,165 staff (4,616 full-time equivalent) in 2023.
- In 2023 1.8% of students and 2.0% of staff were Indigenous Australians.
- 98% of 2022 graduates have undertaken at least one Real World Experience (international or work integrated learning).
- In 2022 QUT's research income of \$125 million was higher than in previous years.
- *Campus to Country*, QUT's award-winning Indigenous Australian campus development strategy, intends to connect campuses to place, both physically and through engagement with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.
- Home to the Carumba Institute, an innovative leader in Indigenous research, education and community engagement, nationally and internationally.
- The first Australian business school to earn 'triple crown' accreditation from the European Foundation for Management Development (EFMD), the Association of MBAs (AMBA) and the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB).
- QUT has had 136 winners of Australian Awards for University Teaching (AAUT) since 2000.
- Ranked equal 189th place in the world in the 2024 QS World University Rankings.
- QUT was ranked equal 199th place in the world in the THE World University Rankings 2024.
- QUT was named Entrepreneurial University of the Year for the Asia-Pacific region in the 2023 Triple E Awards.
- QUT was equal 5th in Australia and 2nd in Queensland for Indigenous Australian award course completions in 2022.
- In 2022 QUT's net carbon emissions were 10% less and waste to landfill was 37% less than in 2018.
- QUT was ranked 100th in the world in the QS World University Rankings: Sustainability 2024.
- QUT was ranked 19th in Communication and Media Studies, 30th in Nursing and 42nd in Engineering – Mineral & Mining in the 2023 QS World University Rankings by Subject.
- Ranked 1st in Communication in Australia and 17th in Nursing in the world in the ShanghaiRanking Global Ranking of Academic Subjects 2023.
