Delivered in the July school holidays, participants will be treated like real QUT undergraduate students, with access to QUT's world class facilities across both Brisbane campuses and participating in a program encompassing all QUT study areas.

The QUT Future You Summit focuses on the theme of Future Frontiers, what will your students' futures be, and how can QUT help them get there?
