## HIGH SCHOOL ENGAGEMENT

## Science & Engineering Challenge

A dynamic four-day event aimed at inspiring Indigenous Australian students in Years 9-10 to explore careers in STEM. This event targets Indigenous school groups and regional schools, with a significant focus on students from low ICSEA backgrounds.

#### **Dean's Awards for Indigenous Excellence**

Recognising outstanding achievements in Design and Engineering for Indigenous Australian students in Years 11 and 12. Awardees receive a gift card and a \$3,000 bursary upon enrolling at QUT.

#### **QUT First Nations STEM Workshops**

Interactive workshops that ignite enthusiasm for STEM, connect students with STEM industries, and link Indigenous Australian heritage with future careers. These workshops are delivered by Indigenous Australian student ambassadors on campus or in schools.

#### **START QUT Intensive**

A comprehensive two-week program for Year 11 students entering Year 12, supported by the QUT Oodgeroo Unit. This program includes accommodation, meals, and social activities, providing a supportive environment for Indigenous Australian students.

#### **CURRENT QUT STUDENTS**

#### **Industry Scholarships**

Our initiative aims to increase scholarships for Indigenous Australian students in Architecture, Built Environment, and Engineering. We collaborate with companies like Arcadia Landscape Architecture, Blaklash, Powerlink, LCI Consultants and Shamrock Civil Engineering to provide educational and employment pathways.

## 5-Day Cultural Immersion Program

An immersive program offering hands-on experience in engineering companies and cultural activities such as learning traditional language and bush tucker. This program highlights the integration of engineering with Indigenous culture and heritage.

#### **Indigenous Australian Innovators Research Experience Scheme**

A paid research program for undergraduate Indigenous Australian students, focusing on real-world problem-solving in areas like renewable energy, health technology, and sustainable urban development. This program serves as a pathway to doctoral research and academic careers.

## **COMMITMENT TO INDIGENOUS** CULTURAL COMPETENCY

QUT's Faculty of Engineering, Architecture and Built Environment has implemented BlackCard cultural capability training across all Schools, integrating Indigenous perspectives into various units, starting with civil engineering and architecture.

Ten Indigenous Associate Fellows have achieved Higher Education Academy status, and unit coordinators are completing training to embed Indigenous knowledge in the curriculum.

We are the only university in QLD with a dedicated Assistant Dean for Engagement with Indigenous Australians, whose role focuses on student engagement and retention, research excellence, enhancing cultural competencies, and building strong industry and community links.
