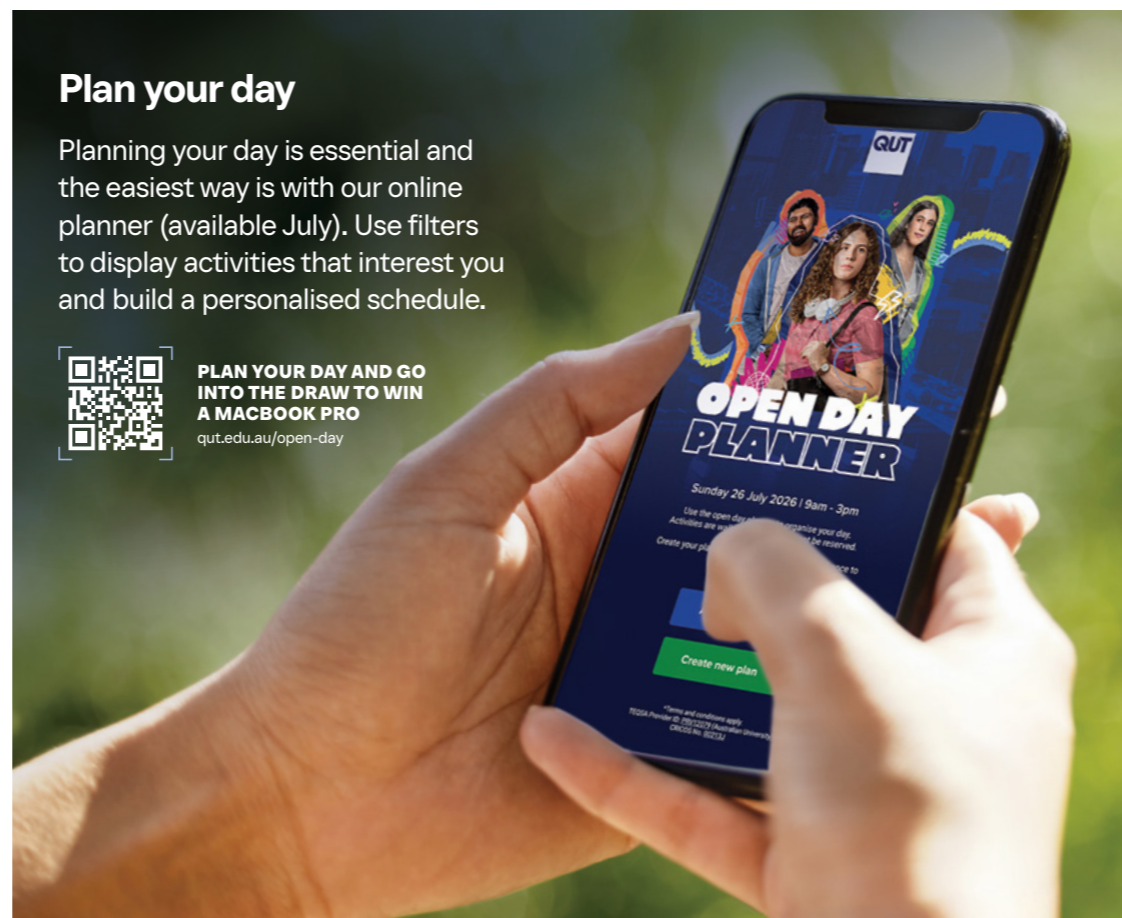

Getting to our campuses

Gardens Point campus

2 George Street, Brisbane



Free parking on campus is limited and we encourage you to take public transport where possible.

Additional free parking is available at Kelvin Grove (and you can catch the free shuttle bus to Gardens Point) or you can access paid parking stations across the CBD.



Walk from the Queen Street or King George Square bus stations, or over the Goodwill Bridge from the Mater Hill or South Bank bus stations.



Catch a train to South Bank station and walk across the Goodwill Bridge. Or catch a train to Central station and walk down George Street.



Catch a CityCat to the QUT Gardens Point ferry terminal.

Kelvin Grove campus

Victoria Park Road, Kelvin Grove



Free parking is available in F Block and J Block car parks on Boundary Road. There are also smaller open-air car parks on campus and paid street parking. Please note, there is limited parking near the Creative Industries Precinct.



Catch a bus to the QUT Kelvin Grove bus station, located on the Northern Busway. There are also bus stops along Kelvin Grove Road within walking distance to campus.



Catch a train to Roma Street train station and connecting bus to QUT Kelvin Grove bus station.



If visiting the Creative Industries Precinct, allow an extra 15 minutes to walk from the Kelvin Grove F Block car park and at least 20 minutes from the J Block car park and QUT Kelvin Grove bus station.

Use the Translink journey planner to access public transport timetables and services at translink.com.au or call 13 12 30.

A free loop shuttle will run at Kelvin Grove campus for visitors with mobility issues, offering stops near J Block car park, A Block forecourt and the Creative Industries Precinct (see map on page 12).

Biomedical sciences

Explore biomedical and medical laboratory sciences in **Q Block**. Perform hands-on experiments, discover how the human body works and chat with academic and research staff. Investigate genomics, microbiome, biochemistry and the emerging field of personalised medicine.

Business

As a future business student, check out our **Z Block** facilities including the student lounge and study areas, televised news and digital announcements. Tour the **Economics and Finance Bloomberg Lab** that gives you access to financial data to conduct real-world financial analysis. Visit **Innovation Central Brisbane** in **V Block** to see how business students work with industry partners to solve real-world problems and develop practical prototypes.

Engineering open house

Check out the engineering labs and workshops in **O and S blocks**. Talk to staff and students about different study options specific to your interests, as well as opportunities to get involved in our many student clubs and societies. On level 11 of **S Block**, visit Australia's top robotics research centre.

Entrepreneurship

QUT Entrepreneurship's award-winning programs inspire students, staff and alumni to realise their entrepreneurial capabilities and empower the next generation of changemakers. Talk to staff at our information tent or take a tour of the **QUT Foundry** in **B Block**, a co-working space to help you on your journey.

IT and games showcase

C Block is home to QUT Law and our newly renovated on-campus courtroom, the **QUT Law Moot Court**, which provides a real-world space for students to sharpen their courtroom skills. Take a tour of the **QUT Law Library**, which provides specialised legal information, resources and access to highly qualified law librarians.

Maths and data immersion

Curious about what it's like to study maths or data science at university? Visit the maths and data immersion in **P Block** to engage in hands-on demonstrations with our expert tutors and chat with our students.

Pharmacy

Experience hands-on pharmacy activities guided by our expert academics in **S Block**. Discover the possibilities for your career by talking to industry professionals and graduates at the **Explore pharmacy tent**.

Radiation therapy

Take a tour of our **Virtual Environment for Radiotherapy Training (VERT)** in **Q Block**, which uses 3D technology to create a virtual environment featuring life-size treatment tables, external beam machines and life-like patients. The VERT will show you the result of a radiation plan you have created for a patient, determine if the angle is correct and if the beam will avoid sensitive body structures and organs.

Science and Engineering Centre

Discover the Science and Engineering Centre in **P Block**, home to collaborative learning and research spaces, food and retail outlets, and a 50-metre swimming pool. The centre also includes The Cube, which at two storeys high is one of the world's largest and most advanced digital interactive learning and display spaces.

Science lab tours

Join our science ambassadors and lab technicians for the popular hands-on, guided tours of our labs. Explore the spaces where QUT students learn to identify rocks, quantify chemical reactions using thermochemistry, utilise dynamics tracks in first-year physics, investigate the foundations of biology and much more.

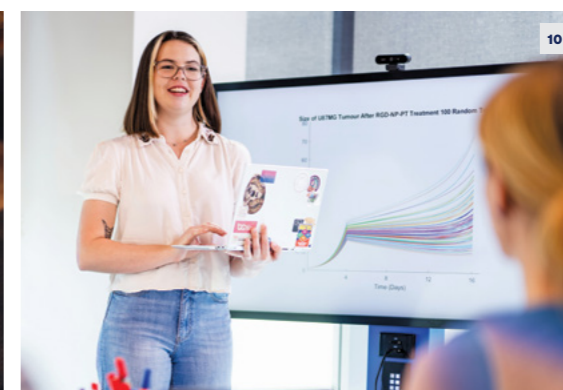
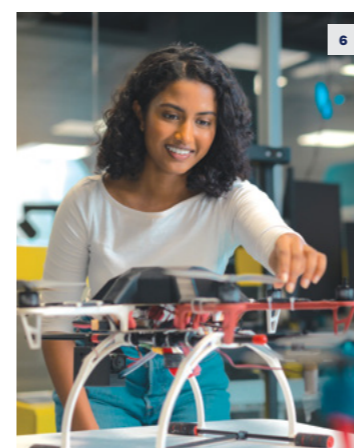
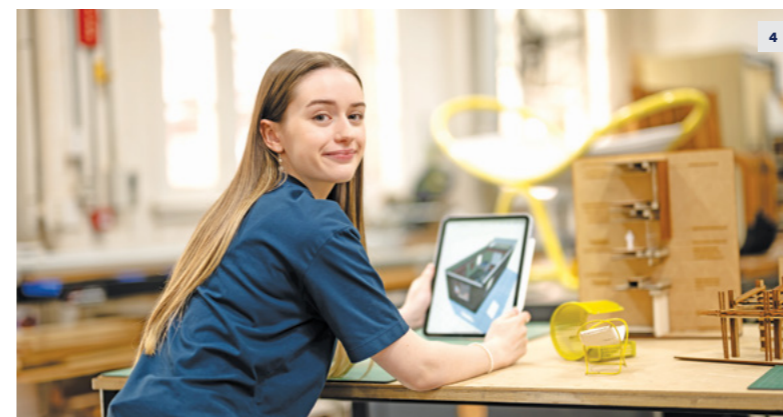
Sport at QUT

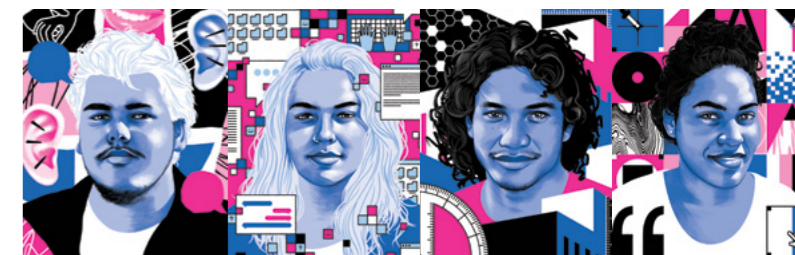
