 - Completing 7 online training modules (total of 6 hours) over a two month period (1 August – 30 September 2024) (modules may be completed all together or at different times).
 - Completion of two short online surveys pre and post training (in July 2024 and October 2024) (approx. 10 minutes each).
 - Completion of a short follow up survey (approx. 10 minutes) 6 months post training (April 2025).

This is a total time commitment of 6 hours and 30 minutes.

Practice Managers will also be asked to participate in a 6-month follow-up interview (approx. 20-30 minutes).
