GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATORS

PURPOSE OF AWARDS

The purpose of the Outstanding Alumni Awards is to recognise graduates of QUT and its predecessor institutions for exceptional professional, academic or research achievements and contributions to the community at the local, state, national or international levels.

The annual event is an initiative of the QUT Alumni Board, which consists of graduates, past and present staff, past and present QUT Council and other qualified members.

Nominations are encouraged for all award categories.

GENERAL RULES OF THE 2019 OUTSTANDING ALUMNI AWARDS

- 1. Any person can nominate a nominee
- 2. Nominees can nominate themselves
- 3. Recipients of Honorary Degrees/Doctorates from QUT cannot be nominated
- 4. Current members of QUT Council cannot be nominated
- 5. Current staff of QUT cannot be nominated
- 6. Previous staff can be nominated providing they meet the eligibility criteria
- 7. Previous winners of any QUT Outstanding Alumni Faculty Awards cannot be nominated
- 8. Previously nominated alumni who were unsuccessful in winning an award may be re-nominated. A new complete nomination must be submitted as if it were the first time they were nominated.
- 9. Permission must be obtained from the nominee prior to submitting the nomination
- 10. Deadline for nominations is 5:00 p.m. Friday, 10 May 2019
- 11. The Eligibility Criteria for each award category the nominee is nominated for, must be met (see over page)

AWARD CATEGORIES AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Award	Criteria
Alumnus of the Year award	The QUT Alumnus of the Year will be chosen from the Faculty Award Winners only.
Young Alumnus of the Year award	All candidates aged up to 35 years at the time of nomination may be considered for the Young Alumnus of the Year Award. They may also be considered for any Special Excellence awards. Undergraduate experiences cannot be recognised within this award, the focus is predominantly on achievements post-graduation. Nominees must comply with all of the following eligibility criteria: • Australian and international graduates of QUT and QIT are eligible candidates for this award; • Demonstration of on-going, high level of achievement in their field and in their service to the community. Past winners have generally had a minimum of 6 years career experience; • Alumni do not have to be working in the particular discipline from which they graduated; • Alumni who are current staff of QUT are NOT eligible for consideration for this award.
Faculty award winner from each of the 6 faculties	 Nominees must comply with all of the following eligibility criteria: Australian and international graduates of QUT, or its predecessor institutions, are eligible candidates for these awards; Demonstration of on-going, high level of achievement in their field and in their service to the community. Past winners have generally had a minimum of 15 years career experience; Alumni do not have to be working in the particular discipline from which they graduated; Alumni who are current staff of QUT are NOT eligible for consideration for this award.
