General English is a great way to improve your English for school, work or everyday life or if you want to study at QUT but your IELTS score is below 5.0. You will learn the core skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening while developing the confidence to communicate fluently in English with other people.

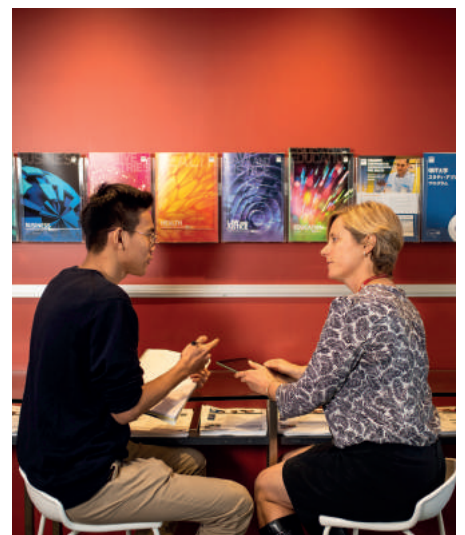
