Leadership in Disaster Management

Overview

The Leadership in Disaster Management short course aims to develop your capacity to lead and manage health organisations, ensuring that they are prepared and capable of managing a major incident or disaster. The course is intended for those likely to be responsible for designing response arrangements, instructing others in those arrangements and for managing health services strategically throughout the response and recovery phases. This program is shared by students enrolled in postgraduate programs at QUT.

Leadership in Disaster Management

- Five-day intensive short course.
- Course developed and delivered by experts in health management and disaster response.
- Ideal for individuals charged with developing policies, plans and capabilities to strategically manage health organisations' response to disasters; and to lead such organisations during response to and recovery from major incidents and disasters. The course will also suit those working toward senior positions potentially involved in or connected to disaster management.

Course structure

- Monday 15 to Friday 19 October 2018, 9am to 5pm daily.
- Delivered at QUT Kelvin Grove campus.
- Recognition of participation.
- Option to undertake assessment for advanced standing in PUN454 in some postgraduate award courses.

The course will include the following elements:

- Strategic, system-wide health planning and management for disasters
- International, national and local planning, consultative and coordination frameworks

- Legal and financial arrangements in terms of management and principle requirements
- Strategic leadership and principles including community and professional engagement
- Research and educational requirements of the system and the application of these requirements
- Future developments in disaster health response.
