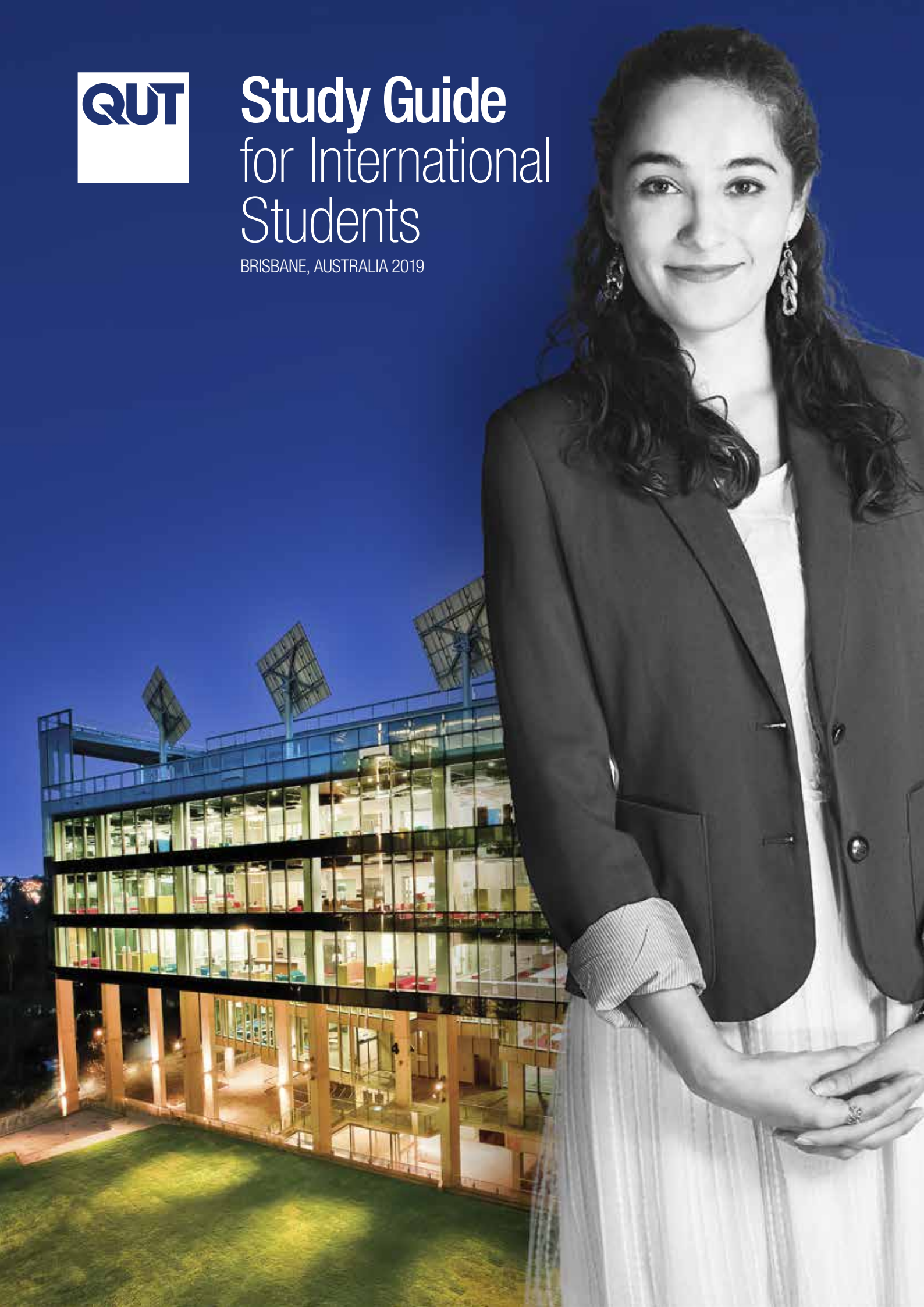

The Bachelor of IT (Honours) majoring in Computer Science graduate, is now Facebook's Engineering Director managing a team of 100 spanning across San Francisco, Seattle, New York, and London.

Creating music for the future/ ALICE-the future of music

QUT computer science graduate **Adam Hibble** and business and law student **Jack Nolan** are the Popgun team, creating artificial intelligence that can play and compose music.

Popgun is using Deep Learning to create an exciting new musical experience, building an AI that can play music with you, like a professional musician. The tool "ALICE" can play and compose music, a great creative tool for musicians and producers as well as a learning tool for those studying music.

Young Alumnus of the Year

Kate Gifford has always had her eyes on the prize.

The internationally-recognised optometrist, is not only the youngest, and only the second woman to be named National President of the profession's peak body – she was named QUT Young Alumnus of the Year (2017) as well.

Kate specialises in the clinical management of myopia (short-sightedness) in children and young adults.

Her passion for education in this field has seen her regularly host students in highly sought-after clinical placements in her practice, particularly QUT students with an interest in paediatric optometry or contact lenses.

Submit your application

Apply using the QUT form available at www.qut.edu.au/international/applying/step-7-submit-your-application. You may need to provide details of previous study or employment and supporting documents (originals or certified copies). Submit your application, including the application fee of A\$100 (including GST) and all certified supporting documents, to QUT or your agent. This fee is non-refundable.

Accept your offer

If your application is successful, we'll send you an offer including Acceptance of Offer and Student Declaration forms. Ensure you meet all conditions (if any) and return your signed Acceptance of Offer form, student declaration and payment to QUT Admissions or your QUT agent.
