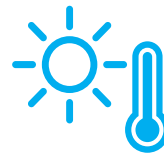

What can you study?

Design your study to suit your interest and to meet the requirements of your home university.

General English (5 week sessions)

- Develop the core skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening
- Increase your fluency and accuracy and develop your confidence
- Elementary to advanced levels available
- Participate in cultural studies, including trips and activities
- Progress to an EAP program when you pass the QUT EAP entry test

English for Academic Purposes - EAP (10 or 15 weeks)

- Develop academic language skills in an Australian university environment
- Improve your language proficiency
- Build your confidence speaking and giving presentations
- Three levels of EAP available (see 'Progression' column on the table)

Study Abroad with Diploma units (13 weeks)

- Develop your language skills while studying academic content

- Diploma units available in business, creative industries, IT, health science and engineering
- You will study with other international students at the College, with access to all QUT facilities
 - You must study a minimum of one communication unit with the diploma subjects
 - Engineering subjects – must have senior high school Maths B
 - To graduate with a QUT Diploma - you must study the standard Diploma program.

Study Abroad with Communications units (13 weeks)

- Study two English Communication units at the College and one or two degree units at the faculty
- This provides a university faculty experience at the same time as English development

Study Abroad (1 semester or 1 year)

Choose three or four faculty units per semester, from across 10 different study areas at both campuses

- General English and EAP programs – no academic entry requirements
- Diploma units - minimum of high school completion
- Study Abroad semester or year - minimum 1 year full-time study at a recognised university with a GPA 5 (10-point scale) or GPA 2.5 (4-point scale) or equivalent 2.5 (4-point scale) or equivalent
