Important information regarding sponsorship

Entry to this course is restricted to employees of companies conducting business in the railway industry, and whose employer is prepared to sponsor their study of this course. Sponsorship may include payment of a student's course fees by the employer, but this is not essential. A student may choose to pay their own up-front fees. However, the employer must sign this form to confirm their commitment to the student undertaking this course of study, regardless of who is paying the course fees.

<u>Please note</u>: in either case, course fees must be paid before the student receives their results. If the employer is paying the course fees on behalf of the student, but the sponsorship doesn't cover failed subjects, the sponsor should pay the QUT invoice then arrange for reimbursement from the student following release of results. Alternatively, the student could pay the fees upfront and be reimbursed by the sponsor rather than making a fee-payment arrangement with QUT.
