NAVIGATING THE PDF

The PDF is designed to open to fit to screen size. There is a bookmark panel on the left which the user can use to jump between sections.

There are also navigational arrows in the bottom corners of the pdf to move to the next

(or previous) page.

There are text fields where students can add their notes.

These fields are denoted by a light blue box.

When the pdf is saved it will retain any text additions.

There are a few activities where the students will have an opportunity to draw directly on to the pdf. There will be instructions on these activity pages to guide the user.


