



ARCADIA LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GENERAL

1. Closing date for applications is 8th March 2021. Late applications will **not** be accepted.
2. To be eligible for the Arcadia Landscape Architecture Indigenous Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

A. ENROLMENT

4. Recipients must remain enrolled as a full-time student at QUT for the duration of the studies to retain their scholarship.
5. After first semester, students are able to take approved Leave of Absence for up to 12 months (in accordance with QUT Student Rules – http://www.mopp.qut.edu.au/E/E_04_05.jsp and still retain the scholarship. Scholarship payments will not be made to the scholar while on an approved Leave of Absence.

B. RECIPIENT PERFORMANCE OBLIGATIONS

6. All Arcadia Landscape Architecture Indigenous Scholarship recipients must maintain a minimum course grade point average (GPA 4.0) or greater in any given semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period. Failure to maintain this condition may result in the scholarship being terminated.

C. SCHOLARSHIP VALUE AND DISBURSEMENT

7. The three-year scholarship valued at \$15,000.00 will be paid at \$5,000.00 per year, for the standard duration of the nominated undergraduate QUT course of study or up to a maximum of \$5,000.00 per year for current students, whichever comes first. This will be paid as cash of \$2,500.00 per semester and will be paid after the last date recipients can withdrawal without academic penalty (normally in May and September each year).
8. While every care is taken to ensure direct payments of scholarship funds are correct, scholarships recipients are required to monitor payments and notify QUT if any over or under payments occur. If under payments occur, the balance will be paid to the student immediately. If over payments occur the scholarship recipient is required to advise QUT immediately and repay the overpaid amount.

D. GRIEVANCES

9. Any grievances arising from the administration of this scholarship is governed by **E/9.2 Grievance resolution procedures for student related grievances** found in QUT's Manual of Policy and Procedures - http://www.mopp.qut.edu.au/E/E_09_02.jsp
10. All scholarship delivery is governed by the QUT Manual of Policy and Procedures, *Chapter E - 11 Prizes, Awards and Scholarships*

E. CONCURRENCY

11. A QUT student is normally only permitted to hold one QUT merit scholarship at any one time however students may be eligible to hold the Arcadia Landscape Architecture Indigenous Scholarship and an Equity Scholarship concurrently.
12. For all intents and purposes the Arcadia Landscape Architecture Indigenous Scholarship is classed as an industry scholarship.
13. The Arcadia Landscape Architecture Indigenous Scholars is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy. The QUT Scholarships Concurrency Policy determines whether certain scholarship combinations can be held by a student concurrently. Refer to the concurrency table provided below.
