APPLICATION

Nominated visual arts students are required to submit an application outlining how they would use the award to enable and enhance their contemporary art skills and contribute to the field of visual arts more broadly.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Recipients must be
 - Second of third year Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts); or
 - Master of Philosophy in Visual Arts

Recipients <u>must</u> also be one of the following:

- Australian or New Zealand citizen
- a permanent resident

RETAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 2. Recipients are expected to maintain full-time enrolment for the duration of their studies to retain this scholarship.
- 3. Recipients must maintain a minimum course grade point average (GPA) of 4.50 or greater in any given semester to maintain the Scholarship for the next study period. Students who fail to maintain this condition will be placed on Scholarship probation in the following semester.
- 4. Recipients wishing to take a break from study must apply for, and be granted, a Leave of Absence. After completing first semester, students can take up to two years of approved leave from their course. Scholarship payments are suspended whist students are on an approved Leave of Absence.
- 5. In the event of special circumstances occurring while in the receipt of this scholarship, students must contact the University Scholarships Coordinator to discuss their situation (<u>scholarships@qut.edu.au</u>). Special circumstances will be taken into consideration to support individual variation to the Bursary retention requirements (supporting documentary evidence may be requested).

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

6. This one-year scholarship is valued at \$10,000.00 and will be paid at the conclusion of Semester 2, 2024.

OTHER INFORMATION

7. This Scholarship is bound by the Concurrency Policy that determines whether certain award combinations can be held concurrently by a student. **This is an Industry scholarship**. Refer to the table below.

To determine if you can hold more than one scholarship, locate Scholarship Type A on the X axis and Scholarship Type B on the Y axis then slide down and across simultaneously until you reach the concurrency decision for that combination.
