### APPLICATION

Students are required to submit an application including –

- a current CV (including portfolio work if available)
- a brief proposal (1-2 pages) outlining achievements and reasons for undertaking study in Acting or Drama at QUT
- statement of any equity disadvantage or hardship in further study. QUT Equity scheme applications can be utilised.

### ELIGIBILITY

1. Recipients must be commencing a -
  - Bachelor of Fine Arts (Drama)
  - Bachelor of Fine Arts (Acting)

Recipients must also be one of the following:

- an Australian or New Zealand citizen; OR
- a permanent resident; OR

### SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS AND ACCEPTANCES

2. Scholarship will be determined by a selection panel and offer made to the highest ranked applicant.
3. Recipients must accept and enroll in one of the above QUT courses to receive this scholarship.
4. This scholarship cannot be deferred.

### RETAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP

5. Recipients are expected to enrol full-time for the duration of the studies to retain this scholarship.
6. Recipients must maintain a minimum course grade point average (GPA) of 5.00 or greater in any given semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period.
7. Recipients wishing to take a break from study must apply for, and be granted, a Leave of Absence. After completing first semester, students can take up to two years of approved leave from their course. Scholarship payments are suspended whilst students are on an approved Leave of Absence.
8. In the event of special circumstances occurring while in the receipt of this scholarship, students must contact the University Scholarships Coordinator to discuss their situation ([scholarships@qut.edu.au](mailto:scholarships@qut.edu.au)). Special circumstances will be taken into consideration to support individual variation to the scholarship retention requirements (supporting documentary evidence may be requested).

### SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

9. The \$5,000 scholarship payment will be made in two payments of \$2,500 each as a stipend after census date in Semester 1 and 2 of the recipients first year.

### OTHER INFORMATION

10. This scholarship is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy that determines whether certain scholarship combinations can be held concurrently by a student. **This is an equity scholarship.** Refer to the following table.

To determine if you can hold more than one scholarship, locate Scholarship Type A on the X axis and Scholarship Type B on the Y axis then slide down and across simultaneously until you reach the concurrency decision for that scholarship combination. The scholarship type can be confirmed in the respective terms and conditions of the scholarship in question.
