ELIGIBILITY

1. To be eligible for a ERM Power Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident, or Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder
- identify as female
- Have a GPA of 6.0 or greater on QUT's 7 point scale
- Be enrolled in your course full-time with two years remaining as at semester 1, 2020
- Be undertaking full-time study in one of the majors listed below in 2020:
 - Bachelor of Information Technology (Computer Science) (IN01)
 - Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Computer and Software Systems) (EN01)
 - Bachelor of Engineering (Computer and Software Systems) (EN40)

Or a relevant double degree listed below:

SCHOLARSHIP ASSESSMENT

2. Scholarship selection will be based on academic performance and responses to the selection criteria, an interview may be required.
3. An ERM Power selection panel will allocate the ERM Power scholarship based on information provided in the application.

SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

4. The scholarship will commence in Semester 1, 2020 and an offer will be made to the successful applicant by the end of March, 2020.
5. These scholarships cannot be deferred.

RETAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP

6. Scholarship recipient must be enrolled full time in the IN01 Computer Science major, EN01 or EN40 Computer and Software Systems major or a relevant double degree for the duration of their studies to retain this scholarship.
7. Scholarship recipient must pass all units and achieve a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 6.0 in QUT's 7 point scale in any given semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period. Failure to maintain this condition may result in the scholarship being terminated.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

8. The scholarship is valued at \$20,000 and will be paid at \$10,000 per year (\$5,000 per semester) for the final two years of undergraduate study.
9. Each scholarship payment will be made following confirmation of enrolment after HECS census date for the semester.
10. While every care is taken to ensure direct payments of scholarship funds are correct, scholarships recipients are required to monitor payments and notify QUT if any over or under payments occur. If under payments occur, the balance will be paid to the student immediately. If over payments occur the scholarship recipient is required to advise QUT immediately and repay the overpaid amount.
11. This scholarship is viewed by the ATO as not taxable income. Please note however that Centrelink may include this scholarship entitlement in any means testing as a result of an application made for commonwealth assistance. Please check with Centrelink for a ruling on this issue when applying for commonwealth assistance.
12. In the event of special, extenuating circumstances while in the receipt of this scholarship, scholars must contact the Science and Engineering Faculty to discuss their situation.
13. This scholarship is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy and is classified as an "Industry Scholarship". The QUT Scholarships Concurrency Policy governs whether certain scholarship combinations can be held by a student concurrently. The table below provides information on what scholarships can be held concurrently at QUT.
