## Information for applicants

## **About the QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarship**

The QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarships have been established to support students who are holders of a Bridging Visa E, Temporary Protection Visa, or Safe Haven Enterprise Visa, and receive an offer to study an undergraduate degree full-time or part-time internally at QUT in Semester 1, 2020.

In Semester 1, 2020 recipients of the QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarship will receive the following:

- A tuition fee scholarship for the duration of your undergraduate degree.
- A guaranteed minimum QUT Equity Scholarship of \$3500 for one year
- An Equity Computer on commencement at QUT

### Who should apply for the QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarship?

You should apply if you are facing significant financial barriers to studying at university, and are:

- a holder of a Bridging Visa E (subclass 050), Temporary Protection Visa (subclass 785), or Safe Haven Enterprise Visa (subclass 790)
- applying for an undergraduate degree full-time or part-time internally at QUT for Semester 1, 2020

Students who are not experiencing financial hardship, should not apply for these scholarships.

## How do I apply?

You can download the form and complete it on your computer. You will then need to print it, sign the declaration/s, attach all supporting documents and submit it.

It is your responsibility to ensure you answer all questions relevant to your situation and provide all relevant supporting documentation.

Applications and all supporting documentation must be submitted by 4:30 pm on Friday, 17 January 2020. We will let you know the outcome by 31 January 2020.

If you are having any difficulties completing the application form or providing the required documentation, please contact the QUT Equity Scholarships team using the contact details below. One of our team will be able to assist you.

#### IMPORTANT: Applying for a place at QUT

To receive the scholarship, you must gain a place in an internal, undergraduate degree at QUT for Semester 1, 2020. This is a separate process. You will need to meet the minimum entry requirements for your chosen degree, including the English language requirement.

If you completed an Australian year 12 program in 2019, apply through QTAC. If you are having difficulty paying the application fee, please contact the Equity Scholarships team.

If you did not complete an Australian year 12 program in 2019, apply directly to QUT. Use the 'Application for Admission to QUT as an International Student' (F) form. There is usually a \$100 fee, but this will be waived if you provide evidence of your visa status with your admission application and indicate that you are applying for the QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarship. ## How is my application assessed?

Academic results are not taken into consideration for these scholarships, only financial need.

Applications for the QUT Asylum Seeker Tuition Fee Scholarship will be scored according to a number of criteria, and will be awarded in order of need.

### Is my application treated confidentially?

Yes. All information and documentation supplied by you will be treated confidentially and in accordance with QUT's Privacy Policy. It will only be disclosed to QUT staff involved in the selection process. #### **Application outcome**

All applicants who submit on-time applications and supporting documentation will be notified of the outcome of their application by 31 January 2020. Please note, applicants will only be eligible to receive the scholarship once they are enrolled internally in an undergraduate course at QUT.

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
