



## Agility Applications Scholarship 2021 Terms and Conditions

Closing date for applications is **14 March 2021**. Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

### ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for an Agility Applications Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:
  - Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident, or Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder
  - Have a GPA of 5.0 or greater
  - Be undertaking their second year of full-time study in one of the majors listed below in semester 1, 2021:
    - Bachelor of Information Technology (Computer Science) (IN01)
    - Bachelor of Information Technology (Information Systems) (IN01)
    - Bachelor of Games and Interactive Environments (Software Technologies) (IN05)
    - Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Computer and Software Systems) (EN01)
    - Bachelor of Engineering (Computer and Software Systems) (EN40).
  - Paid employment of any nature, with any employer, undertaken by the recipient must not interfere with the student's study program. The University reserves the right to terminate the award if progress - as a result of additional paid work being undertaken - is not satisfactory.

### SCHOLARSHIP ASSESSMENT

- Scholarship assessment is based on a combination of academic achievement, responses to the selection criteria and, if shortlisted for interview, responses to the interview questions.
- A shortlist of up to 5 applicants will undergo an interview by a panel comprised of a minimum of two people including a representative from the Science and Engineering Faculty and a representative of Agility Applications Pty Ltd.

### SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

- The scholarship will commence in semester 1, 2021 and an offer will be made to the successful applicant by the end of April 2021.
- The successful scholarship recipient will be required to:
  - meet with Agility Applications representatives
  - provide a letter of thanks to Agility Applications Pty Ltd, and
  - participate in an online news story about the scholarship.
- This scholarship cannot be deferred.

### RETAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship recipient must be enrolled full time in one of the eligible courses for the duration of their studies to retain this scholarship.
- The scholarship recipient must pass all units and achieve a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 5.0 in each semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period. Failure to maintain this condition may result in the scholarship being terminated.



## Agility Applications Scholarship 2021 Terms and Conditions

### SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

9. The scholarship is valued at \$8,000 and will be paid at \$4,000 per semester for two semesters.
10. Each scholarship payment will be made after HECS census date for the semester.
11. While every care is taken to ensure direct payments of scholarship funds are correct, scholarship recipients are required to monitor payments and notify QUT if any over or under payments occur. If under payments occur, the balance will be paid to the student immediately. If over-payments occur the scholarship recipient is required to advise QUT immediately and repay the overpaid amount.
12. QUT does not withhold PAYG tax from coursework scholarship payments. It is the recipient's responsibility to check the tax implications for your scholarship and personal circumstances. For advice on whether or not your scholarship is taxable, use the Australian Taxation Office's scholarship decision tool. Please also note that Centrelink may include this scholarship entitlement in any means testing as a result of applications made for commonwealth assistance. 13. In the event of special, extenuating circumstances while in the receipt of this scholarship, scholars must contact the Science and Engineering Faculty to discuss their situation.
14. For all intents and purposes the Agility Applications Scholarship is classed as an Industry scholarship.
15. This scholarship is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy. The QUT Scholarships Concurrency Policy governs whether certain scholarship combinations can be held by a student concurrently. The table below provides information on what scholarships can be held concurrently at QUT.
