Closing date for applications is 13 March, 2022. Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. To be eligible for a David Klingberg Memorial Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident, or Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder.
 - Have a GPA of 5.5 or greater.
 - You must be in your second year of full-time study in one of these courses in semester 1, 2022:
 - EN01 Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
 - o EN40 Bachelor of Engineering (Civil)

Students enrolled in one of the following double degrees are also eligible if in semester 1, 2022 they will be entering the equivalent of their second year of an Engineering course majoring in Civil Engineering:

- o IX59 Bachelor of Business / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
- SE60 Bachelor of Information Technology / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
- SE40 Bachelor of Mathematics / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
- SE80 Bachelor of Science / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
- ID14 Bachelor of Design / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil)
- o ID19 Bachelor of Design (Architecture) / Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil).
- Students who currently hold a \$30,000 Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship are not eligible for this scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP ASSESSMENT

- 2. Scholarship assessment is based on a combination of academic achievement, responses to the selection criteria and, if shortlisted for interview, responses to the interview questions.
- 3. A shortlist of up to 5 applicants will undergo an interview by a panel comprised of a minimum of two people including a representative from the Science and Engineering Faculty and a representative of Wagstaff Piling Pty Ltd.

SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

- 4. The scholarship will commence in Semester 1, 2022 and an offer will be made to the successful applicant by the end of April, 2022.
- 5. The successful scholarship recipient will be required to:
 - meet with representatives of Wagstaff Piling Pty Ltd, and potentially the family of David Klingberg,
 - provide a letter of thanks to Wagstaff Piling Pty Ltd, and potentially the family of David Klingberg, and
 - participate in an online news story about the scholarship.
- 6. This scholarship cannot be deferred.

RETAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP

- 7. The scholarship recipient must be enrolled full time in one of the eligible courses for the duration of their studies to retain this scholarship.
- 8. The scholarship recipient must pass all units and achieve a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 5.5 in each semester to maintain the scholarship for the next study period. Failure to maintain this condition may result in the scholarship being terminated.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

- 9. The scholarship is valued at \$30,000 and will be paid at \$10,000 per year (\$5,000 per semester) for three years.
- 10. Each scholarship payment will be made after HECS census date for the semester.
- 11. While every care is taken to ensure direct payments of scholarship funds are correct, scholarships recipients are required to monitor payments and notify QUT if any over or under payments occur. If under payments occur, the balance will be paid to the student immediately. If over-payments occur the scholarship recipient is required to advise QUT immediately and repay the overpaid amount.
- 12. Although QUT does not take any tax off the award amount, QUT is not authorised to deem this scholarship tax exempt. Ultimate determination regarding the tax status of the scholarship will be made by the Australian Taxation Office. Please retain this statement with your tax documentation. - 13. In the event of special, extenuating circumstances while in the receipt of this scholarship, scholars must contact the Science and Engineering Faculty to discuss their situation.
- 14. For all intents and purposes the David Klingberg Memorial Scholarship is classed as an Industry scholarship.
- 15. This scholarship is bound by the Scholarship Concurrency Policy. The QUT Scholarships Concurrency Policy governs whether certain scholarship combinations can be held by a student concurrently. The table below provides information on what scholarships can be held concurrently at QUT.
