## 2022 Lord Mayor's Multicultural Round Table & QUT Business School Scholarship

---

### Application Package

The Lord Mayor's Multicultural Round Table Committee and QUT Business School (QBS) proudly support this scholarship. It is designed to assist a student from a culturally and linguistically diverse background enrolled in a single, double or post-graduate business degree. The successful applicant will receive a scholarship of up to \$7,000 to cover their educational expenses for a maximum period of two years.

#### Who is Eligible?

The scholarship is available to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- is commencing full-time study in a Bachelor of Business single or double degree at QUT Business School;
- is commencing full-time study in a 1.5 or 2-year Master of Business program at QUT Business School;
- is a continuing undergraduate business student with a minimum of 192 credit points remaining on plan and a minimum overall GPA of 4.5;
- is a continuing post-graduate student in a Master of Business, with at least 144 credit points remaining on plan and a minimum overall GAP of 4.5.

In addition, the applicant must:

- reside in the Brisbane City Council local government region;
- be from a culturally and linguistically diverse background (migrant or refugee) with at least one parent born overseas;
- preferably speak a language other than English;
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- have a personal narrative to share about their cultural inclusion journey in Australia;
- be willing to promote the cultural diversity agenda in university and Brisbane communities.

Follow the steps on pages 2-4. Applications must be typed, well presented, and address all the selection criteria.

## Selection Criteria

---

A competitive selection process will be undertaken based on applicant suitability to the criteria; demonstrated engagement with personal and professional development activities; and willingness to fulfil the responsibilities associated with cultural ambassadorship. Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview with the selection panel.

**Applicants are advised that Conditions of Award are associated with accepting this merit scholarship, including:**

- Maintaining full-time enrolment, a minimum GPA 4.5 and passes in all units for the scholarship duration.
- Supplying a progress report each semester to the sponsor, the Brisbane Lord Mayor's Office (LMO).
- Willingness to be a Multicultural Student Ambassador, supporting CALD (Culturally and Linguistically Diverse) engagement activities initiated by QUT and the LMO, as negotiated.
- Willingness to consult with a Senior Careers Educator for career goal planning and implementation.
- Willingness to undertake mentoring with a CALD business owner, organised in conjunction with LMO.

NB. This is a non-academic achievement scholarship. Under QUT's Concurrency Rules students may hold other scholarships while being in receipt of this scholarship.

4. What are your career ambitions? Explain how you intend to develop the necessary skills, experience and connections through co-curricular and extra-curricular activities to help you prepare for this outcome?
5. How will this scholarship support your studies and career ambitions?

#### **Part 5 – Referees**

Please provide letters of support from two referees (eg. study, work or personal references), ensuring their contact details are included.

#### **Finalise your application**

Please check that you have completed the following before submitting your application:

- Addressed all 5 sections of the application package
- Completed and attached the cover sheet
- Checked spelling and grammar
- Attached referee reports and academic results (QUT is not necessary)

You are NOT required to attach academic results from studies at QUT. By submitting an application, you are providing QUT Business School with permission to access your academic results from the University Student Information System as part of the application assessment process.
